

Monthly Plan Premium for People who get Extra Help from Medicare to Help Pay for their Prescription Drug Costs

Low Income Subsidy Premiums for this Plan Year

Medicare provides Part D premium and cost-sharing assistance to beneficiaries who qualify for the program's low-income subsidy, also called the LIS. An enrollee's monthly plan premium will generally be lower once he or she receives extra help from Medicare if the enrollee joins a PHP Medicare plan with a monthly premium. If you qualify for extra help, the amount of extra help you receive will determine your total monthly plan premium as a member of our Plan.

The premiums listed include coverage for both medical services and prescription drug benefits.
